B. Carnival preliminary report

Lisa Suidgeest presented the report.

1. Ticket sales are down according to the numbers. Last year there were 27,000 tickets sold and this year there were 22,700. (At this point there were more used than sold) Game tickets and mini raffle tickets will be doubled checked.
2. Popcorn and cotton candy sales = \$199.
3. 56-2 liters of pop were left over.
4. Country store went great.
5. 7 of the games were up and the rest down in ticket sales.
6. Large ticket sales were at \$16,885 as of Wednesday.
7. Mini raffle tickets up this year at \$4,200 in presales. Ticket sales during the carnival totaled \$800. This is up from last year by almost double. This number will be reviewed.
8. The value of mini raffle prizes was \$7,500. One hundred and six local businesses donated prizes. We had 123 winners.

Lisa Suidgeest is stepping down from the Carnival and Sheryl Middleton is taking over the position. Lisa was presented with a gift for her wonderful work with the carnival.
