

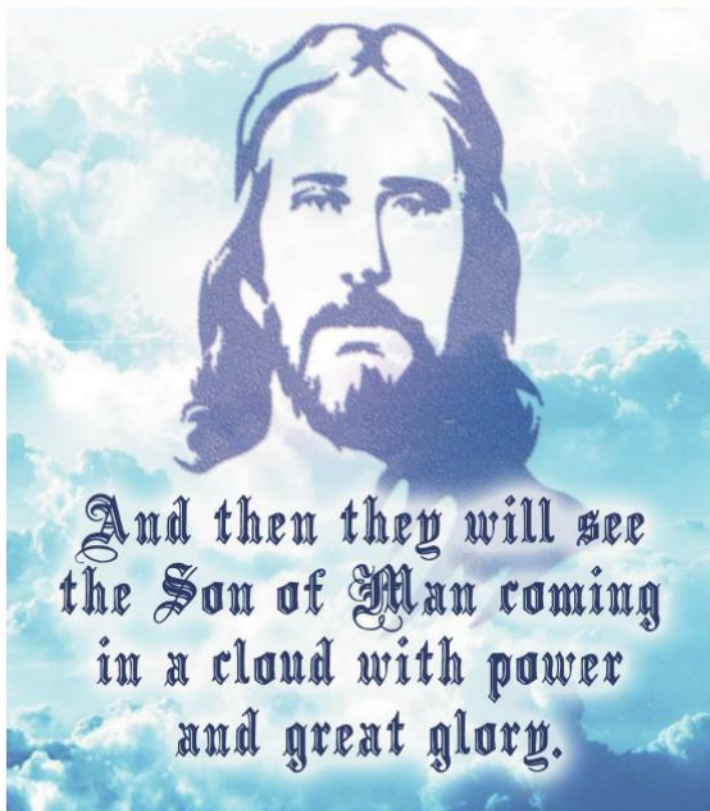

**I WAS HUNGRY, AND
YOU GAVE ME TO EAT**

We all saw the news footage last August, transport planes taking off from Kabul, Afghanistan carrying refugees and evacuees prior to the U.S. pulling out of that country. Some of the video was heart-wrenching with people hanging on to airplane wheel housings as they took off; people being crushed against the airport gates trying to get on a flight out of Afghanistan - now ruled by the Taliban. Their hopes were to get to the United States.

After being vetted by the federal government, these Afghans, many who assisted the U.S. against the Taliban, are here. And by here, I mean Lansing. Area deacons met last week with Judi Harris, Director of Refugee Services for St. Vincent Catholic

Charities. She told us that 300 will be settled in Lansing and will have many needs going forward. We will keep you posted as to specifics.

The first need is to feed the 100 or so who are being housed in motels at the moment, prior to getting permanent housing. They need to be fed. Harris says the need, perhaps surprisingly, is not for food or money. They need people to cook meals for two hours a day at the Cristo Rey Center on High Street in Lansing. You can sign-up for any day you are available. Five-man teams cook Afghan food (recipes are already there). To sign-up for what would be a great Advent project, go to ELcatholics.org. There's a link at the bottom of the homepage that takes you directly to a sign-up page.

VOCATIONS

These are the last paragraphs of my column on the last Sunday of November and I have yet to

mention the fact that November is Vocations Awareness month. St. Joseph has always had a strong, faithful parishioner base, but unfortunately it has not produced a priest since Fr. Doug Osborne in 1969. We all know the number of priests in the diocese has been steadily declining. We need to help stop that trend by first, encouraging our young people to consider calls to the religious life; and secondly, by praying for vocations.

God doesn't have a calendar, so he will hear our prayers in any month, not just November. Take the Traveling Chalice home and pray for vocations regularly that we may see an increase in priests, sisters and deacons. And men, take it from me, the Lord can call you at any time for the diaconate. Don't leave your spiritual phone on silent.

**Dobbs v. Jackson Women's
Health Organization**

Beginning at 10:00 a.m. on December 1st, the Supreme Court of the United States will hear oral arguments in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization. In the case, the court will be determining whether Mississippi can ban elective abortions after 15 weeks gestation. Some of the questions the Justices will be considering strike right at the core of Roe v. Wade—which legalized abortion in 1973—signifying that they may overturn Roe and return the power of abortion regulation to the people.



The decision is expected next summer and after 48 years and over 61 million babies lost to abortion, America could finally see the end to the needless destruction of children in the womb. Please join us as we pray for the witnesses defending life in the oral arguments as well as the Supreme Court Justices who will be deciding whether or not the unborn will be allowed their God-given right to life.
