

# A HOLIER FAMILY PLEASE

Virtually all of the time I light a candle in front of the statues of the Holy Family, I ask Mary and Joseph to intercede for me with the Lord that He bless my family that it become holier. (Sometimes {1 of 10}, I have a prayer that calls for a rapid response, even though I know that God operates on his own time, not mine). I know that we can all become holier, so a prayer for holiness is always in order.

I pray to the Holy Family for a holier family because, "duh", they are "The Holy Family."

And what a coincidence that this should be on my mind today - the feast of "The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph." Actually today's Gospel selection from Luke is probably my favorite

of the multiple Holy Family readings in the Church's threeyear liturgical cycle. And I like it for the exact opposite reason I offer my regular Holy Family intercessory prayers to Mary and Joseph. I normally pray for a holier family, while in today's gospel we have the Holy Parents "normal" parent-child in situation - allowing for a liberal understanding of the "normal."

Many of us parents have had some sort of experience of a lost child. Even if it is only for a few minutes, a great feeling of anxiety sweeps over us. Mary and Joseph had that same panicky feeling when they realized that Jesus wasn't anywhere in their traveling party as they were heading back from Jerusalem to Nazareth after Passover. They may have thought he was just sitting in the back of another wagon playing a Jewish version of "Go Fish" with his buddy Buddv.

Of course, Jesus was instead in

the middle of teachers in the temple (which was the first place I always looked if one of my kids was missing). Mary posed a very typical motherly question upon finding Jesus: "Son, why have you done this to us?" (NOTE: It's ALWAYS the kid's fault.) And Jesus responded with a standard 12-year-old's answer: "Why were you looking for me? (in 21stcentury lingo "So what's the big deal?) As I mentioned earlier, most of us parents can relate. This is a story that shows the humanity of Jesus and a typical parent-child interaction. It brings to light the "family" part of Holy Family.

Now, that being said, I would be remiss if I didn't say this: The whole scenario almost falls completely apart for me when Luke tells us that Jesus left with them and was **obedient**. What parent can relate to that???
