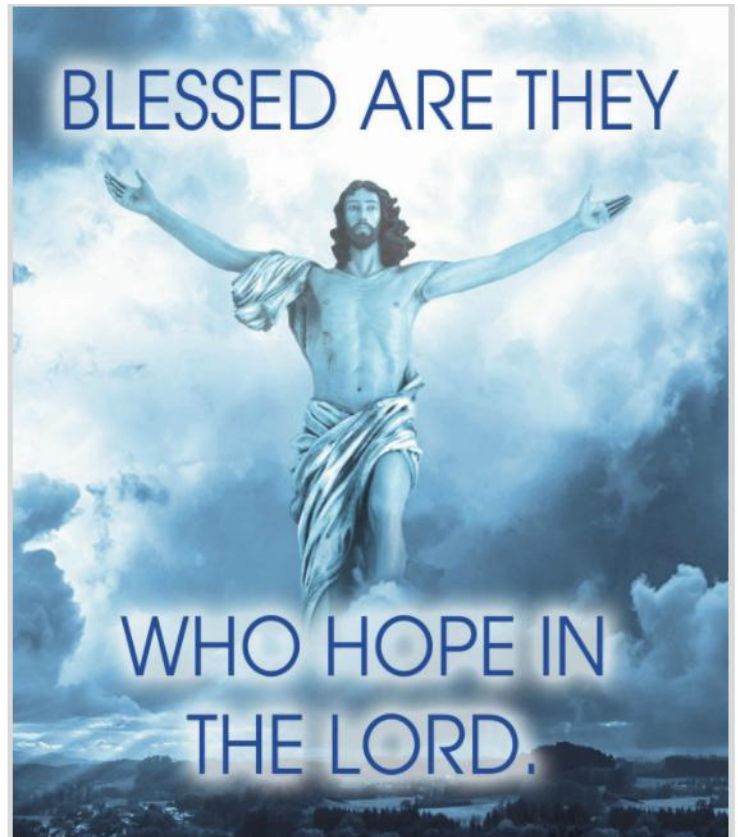

POPE on HOPE 2.0

Last week, we examined the theological virtue of hope as a virtue of confident expectation. Today we will look at the flip-side, when, among other hurdles, we will see overconfidence in our expectation as one of a variety of sins against hope. As I did last week, I will again lean on the writings of Msgr. Charles Pope, a nationally-known Catholic priest and author.

Pope notes that St. Thomas Aquinas and the Catechism are quite clear about our need to guard against two sins against hope - despair and presumption. The catechism's definition of despair is when one *"ceases to hope for his personal salvation from God, for help in attaining it or for the forgiveness of sins. Despair is contrary to God's goodness."* (CCC 2091) The sin is in our rejection of the Lord's graces and not, for example, in a deep sadness we may feel when

dealing with grief.

Despair, Pope says, *"is common today when we too easily conclude that it is not possible to live the holy life to which God summons us...(and) because it denies that God's grace can equip us...to live holy lives."* He says that "confident expectation" we talked about last week *"pertains to things that are difficult, but not impossible."* Taking care of the poor, as St. Luke emphasizes in today's gospel, can be difficult, yet as Christians we are expected to do so. Certainly we are aware that following Christ presents challenges, yet the reward that hope gives us through his graces allows us the opportunity to join him in eternal life. Aquinas lists the sin of sloth as an offshoot of despair, because some people believe it is just too hard to live the life God expects from us. Sadly for them, the great reward we see is not worth their effort.

The second sin against hope is that of presumption - which the catechism breaks into two categories: one in which man presumes he can get himself to heaven without God's help, and

the other is when he presumes God's mercy is so great that his sins will be forgiven no matter how he lives his life. (Paraphrased from CCC 2092). The second, which we can call **"over-confident expectation"** is quite common. "At too many funerals," Pope says, *"bold 'canonizations' take place."* This attitude is summed up in the Book of Sirach: *"Of forgiveness be not overconfident, adding sin upon sin. Say not: 'great is his mercy; my many sins he will forgive.'"* (Sir 5:5-6)

We must remember that our God is a God of mercy, but that mercy comes from our confession of our sins and our true desire to avoid them in the future. But our God is also a God of justice. If we put all of our eggs in the mercy basket without seeking the Lord's forgiveness and graces, we may be presuming our basket doesn't have a big hole in the bottom. I, for one, choose not to make that presumption.
