

#### DIVINE MERCY, SUFFERING AND FR. STU

Opening Note: Today is Divine Mercy Sunday, when all Catholics are urged to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00 p.m. There is a Divine Mercy Service at the Cathedral, but if you can't make it there, go to the parish YouTube channel and pray in concert with other parishioners. Today is the eighth day in the Octave of Easter, now known as Divine Mercy Sunday, as sonamed in April, 2000 by then-Pope John Paul II. Its origin is in a 1931 revelation to St. Faustina in which Jesus told her:

Encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you....
Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death.... When they say this

chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful savior.... I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy.

The mercy of God is endless, and we should never believe that we are unworthy of his forgiveness. If we have been carrying the weight of great sin thinking the Lord would never help a person in such straits, think again. Jesus suffered and died on the cross in order to open the gates of heaven for us. What greater sign of a merciful God do we need?

Speaking about suffering, there is a new movie out that is getting plenty of attention in Catholic media - some of it good, some of it "not so much." It's called "Fr. Stu", and it is based on the reallife story of a hard-edged boxer turned priest. I won't recommend it or discourage people from seeing it, but I will say that it has been what I will call "Hollywoodized." (For example, I don't think any of us have been to a baptism where a muscular man takes off his shirt to be baptized.)

The second half of the movie is powerful, as it explores suffering, mercy, and total trust in God. That will make the movie worthwhile for a lot of Catholics. But it is rated "R" for a reason. and that's because of language. If one has a low threshold of tolerance for foul language then you may not be able to wade through it to reach the part where the powerful message is delivered. If that's the case, then check online for the inspirational true story of Fr. Stuart Long. His transformation was phenomenal.

#### UNLIMITED ABORTION PETITION CIRCULATING:


