**Tis the Season, Season
Two That Is**

So you thought you were getting a Christmas column, just because the word "tis" is in the title. It's funny how a word, though not identifying anything, is then identified with something even though that something, in and of itself, has not yet been identified. "Tis" is just a contraction that means "it is." However, it is a contraction that immediately makes one think of the Christmas season because of its inclusion in the popular Christmas song Deck the Halls with Boughs of Holly. So why is it in the title of this column if this is not about Christmas? It's as simple as this: "Tis" a trick-- a lure into reading again about "The Chosen," the wildly popular streaming series about Jesus, available only by downloading the phone app for free or buying the series on DVD.

Last spring, about 25 people gathered at St. Joe's once a week to watch the first season of the series

together. I moderated a discussion following each episode. Many of the participants downloaded the app to watch the episodes a second time because there is much that is missed the first time around. "Tis" the season for Season Two. I will moderate Season Two of "The Chosen" on Thursday evenings from 6:30 to 8:00 beginning October 6th. (I will not be able to offer it in the mornings this time around however, because of new commitments.)

I would encourage not only those who joined us in viewing the first season, but others as well. That being said, to keep the characters straight, it would be beneficial to view the first season beforehand. If you like to binge-watch programs, it takes about six hours to get through the eight-episode season. "Tis" available on Google Play and in the Apple App store. I would ask that those who plan to attend to please sign up with the parish office so I can prepare the proper amount of material.

This is not all that is going to be offered around here for your spiritu

al growth this fall. The St. Monica's Auxiliary is sponsoring a day retreat for women of the parish this Saturday, October First, at the St. Francis Retreat Center. They will also have their annual Advent gathering in December. The Knights of Columbus are also sponsoring a seasonal family-oriented event on the first Sunday of Advent. Bible study groups are also back up and running.

One more piece of information for parents and grandparents of teenagers: Please encourage your teenager to join the parish Youth Group. Early sign-up numbers have been very low and it is more important than ever that our youth are armed with the Truth as they enter adulthood. The focus this fall is on the Theology of the body and vocations.

So as you can see, "Tis" the season for spiritual growth. Chose "The Chosen" or any other extra-liturgical offering and draw closer to the Lord.
