

He is Risen

Resurrection Day never gets old, does it? Every year between March 22rd and April 25th we celebrate Resurrection Day, more commonly referred to as Easter Sunday. The date changes because it is celebrated on the first Sunday after the full moon that occurs on or after the spring equinox. From year to year we don't know if we will be wearing overcoats or short-sleeved shirts to Easter Mass, but we do know that we will be celebrating the day that Jesus resurrected from the tomb -- rising in glory after his crucifixion.

It really doesn't matter what Sunday we celebrate it, what matters is that through his death and resurrection, Jesus opened up the gates of heaven for us. Without his sacrifice there would be no need to worry about a full moon after an

equinox, for there would be no opportunity for us to spend eternity with the Lord.

Amid the joy today, as we celebrate the end to the Lenten season, let us reflect on what we accomplished in the previous 40 days. Let's ask ourselves how much of the commitment we made through our increased prayer, fasting and almsgiving we can hang onto. After all, the true test of Lent isn't what we can do differently in our lives for a 40-day period, but which of the changes we made for Lent we can maintain. The call to repent in Lent is not a call for temporary change, but for permanent change. Lenten sacrifices are all about becoming better Christians - all for the glory of Jesus who willingly suffered and died for our sins.

All that aside, let's celebrate today in the manner to which we are accustomed, whether that be a family get-together, an Easter egg hunt or a great meal with family. The days are getting longer (and hope-

fully warmer), the kids are preparing for the final quarter of the school year and the baseball season has just begun. For all our struggles and woes, there is much good in our lives regardless of how well we fared in meeting our Lenten goals. After all, we have a God who loves us to the point of sacrificing his own Son that we may have a chance to join him in heaven eternally.

Congratulations and welcome to all those who came into Full Communion with the church at the Easter Vigil Mass. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is an intercessory prayer that asks the Lord to send His mercy upon us and upon everyone living in the world. It is prayed using the rosary and takes ten minutes to pray. The chaplet is traditionally said during the hour of mercy, the 3:00 pm hour. According to the Diary of St. Faustina, Jesus promised that all who recite this chaplet at the hour of death or in the presence of the dying will receive great mercy. The Vatican has approved Jesus' promises to St. Faustina regarding the Chaplet, Divine Mercy Sunday & the Divine Mercy picture. You may want to research the many promises of mercy that Jesus made to St. Faustina. The chaplet is an intercessory prayer that extends the offering of the Eucharist so it is especially appropriate to pray it after receiving the Eucharist at Mass.

Please join the Path of Divine Mercy Grief Ministry after the last Saturday Mass each month when the Divine Mercy Chaplet is said for the parishioners who died during the month.



What is Trinity House?


