Feeling Blessed

I had several possibly humorous thoughts run through my noggin today regarding my quick trip to Florida for a couple Tiger games last week. But in my second column re-boot I thought a reflection on the week is most appropriate.

Normally I wouldn't plan to be away for the start of Lent, but my friend who does all the planning set the dates and I was already in the hole for a round-trip ticket to Tampa before I realized that this was going to overlap with Ash Wednesday. This trip with high school friends has been going on for the last five years and I likely wouldn't be seeing all of them together until next year if I backed out.

So I went and came back feeling blessed. Most of us went to Mass each of the three full days we were in the Tigers home-away-from-home city of Lakeland. We received our ashes on Wednesday and observed the fast and

abstinence regulations for Ash Wednesday and Friday and we talked -- some of it was about baseball, but was mostly about faith and life. And the term "feeling blessed" was used repeatedly. The trip was about baseball and friends, but the result was much more akin to the spiritual feeling one experiences after a weekend at the St. Francis Retreat Center.

There were four of us who spent the whole time together as we reflected on some of our high school memories at Detroit Catholic Central and how the school's motto of "Goodness, Discipline and Knowledge" ended up playing such important roles in our lives -- allowing us to use our gifts for the greater good. Though we did lament some of our fellow classmates passing's over the years, as well as the down cycles of our own lives, we came back to the concept repeatedly of how blessed we have been. All of us, for example, have benefited from being married just once and still have wives who put up with us.

I apologize if this column seems a bit self-indulgent, but I thought much of what my friends and I experienced is

applicable to all of us and that is the consolations we can receive from the Lord if we just take the quiet time to reflect on all he has given us. Even if we are in difficult straits due to finances, illness, unemployment or whatever, Lent offers us the opportunity to appreciate what the Lord has done for us. Jesus went out to the desert to pray for 40 days -- quiet time until rudely interrupted by the devil. We don't need to go out into the desert, but we do need to find more quiet time this Lent to contemplate the gifts God has given us, regardless of our ages.

As for the baseball fans hoping to get some inside info on the Tigers for this year consider this: the game before we arrived in Florida they scored one run. The game after we left they were shut out -- zero runs. The two games we attended they scored a total of 28 runs. Either we brought them good luck and should be awarded season passes or exhibition game scores are meaningless. Take your pick.

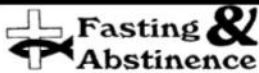

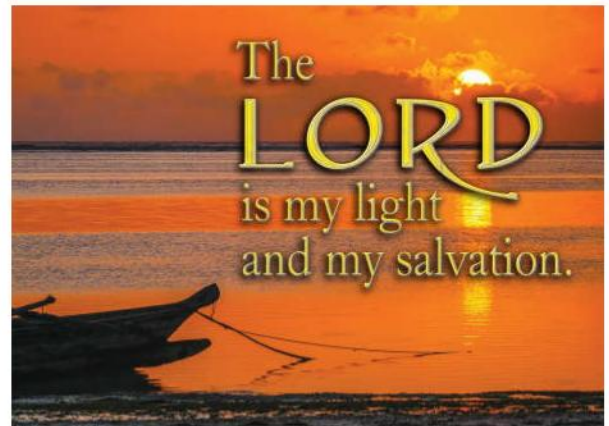


Age 14 and up - Abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

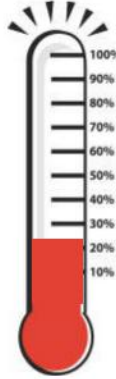
