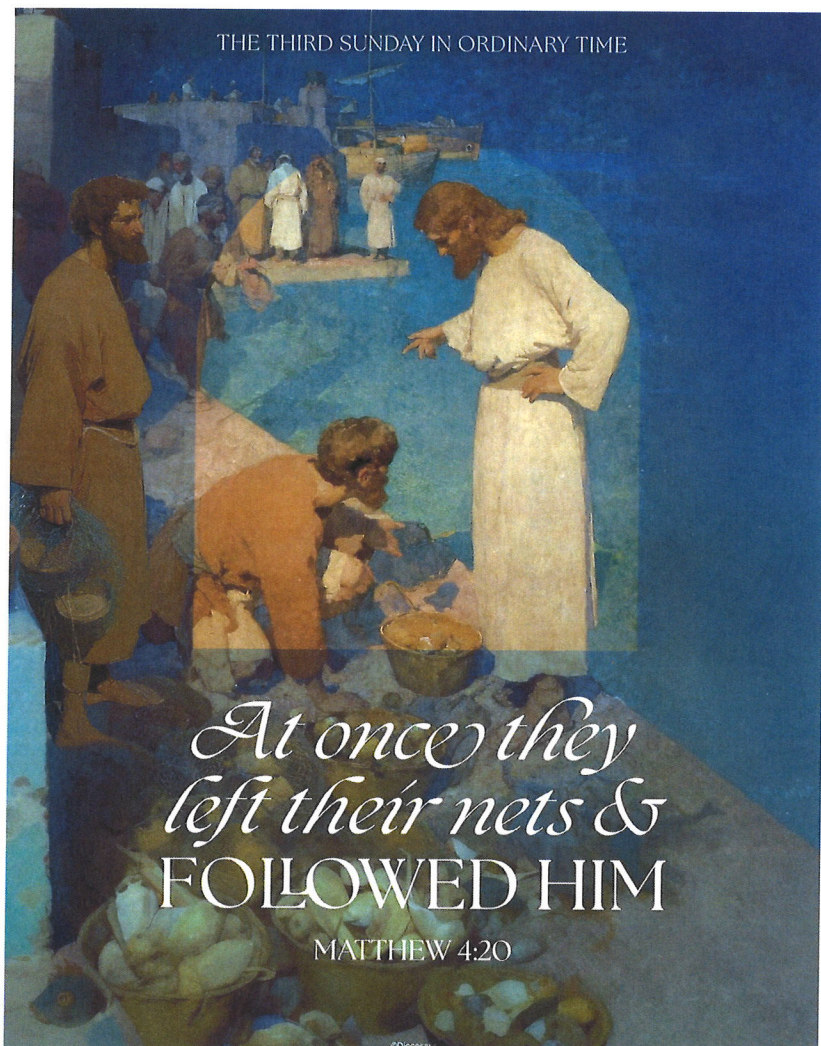

**I Want Something Different**

First of all, the title above should not be confused with a bizarre 1970's film produced by the British comedy troupe "Monty Python's Flying Circus" who put together a series of comedy bits called "And Now For Something Completely Different." No, "I Want Something Different" is completely different than "And Now For Something Completely Different" because it references a Lenten program coming up at St. Joe's and has nothing to do with comedy bits about dead parrots (very funny, by the way) or how to win a fruit throwing fight.

If you picked up a church bulletin last weekend, then you received an orange sheet promoting our Lenten Book Study starting in mid-February. This is for everyone who wants the personal spiritual growth that comes with improving our relationship with God this Lent. It's for everyone else as well. Sometimes we really try to improve our prayer life in Lent by perhaps saying a daily rosary, or watching a daily four-minute video

from Matthew Kelly, Bishop Barron or other Catholic presenters. But after a couple years of repeating that Lenten routine we feel like something's missing in our spiritual life. That's where this book study comes into play. In his book, *Into His Likeness*, Dr. Edward Sri helps us to take the step many of us have wanted to take, but have not been able to do so. It could be a time element (I don't have the time to read a book) or a fear factor (if I become a disciple, what might the Lord then expect of me) that has kept us from taking the step necessary to come close enough to Jesus to theoretically get dust from his feet on our garments.

An invitation to join us in this book study, which will be offered at four different times in an attempt to meet virtually anybody's schedule, in some respects will be seen as a challenge by many. Good—feel challenged, don't run away from it. We grow when we face difficulties in life and find a way to overcome them. Whether it's sports, our jobs, parenting or praying, we can only get over the hurdles in life by meeting them head-on.

Dr. Sri (sounds like three) writes in a very understandable manner. He doesn't use theological terms that

leave the average person running for a dictionary. His style makes for very understandable reading. Each week of the book study will be on 20 to 30-page sections, which will likely take readers 30-45 minutes of reading a week. In order to meet the challenge we must then think about what we read, maybe underline something meaningful to us. Maybe formulate an in-depth answer to one of Sri's questions.

Here's the tentative line-up, Tuesday evenings w/me, Wednesday afternoons with Debbie, Friday evenings with Amanda and on-line Saturday mornings with Bridgette. These could change slightly based on sign-ups. Plan on one of these times and bring a spouse or a friend or two to make your group "homey." And let's tackle together Dr. Sri's question: "Do we want a closer relationship with Christ, and if so, how can we make Jesus the center of our lives?"

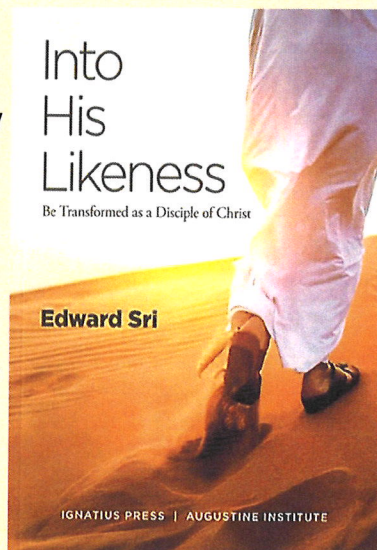
**Walk Closer to Christ This Lent**

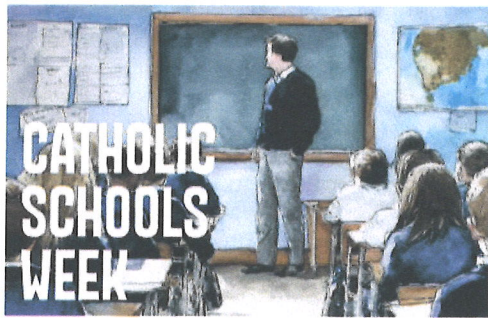

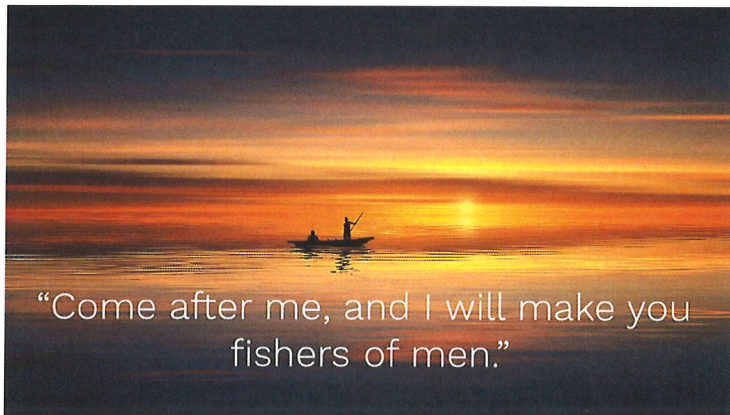
**PLEASE NOTE:**

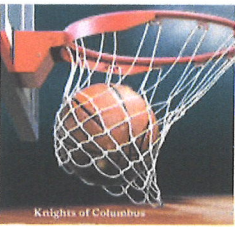

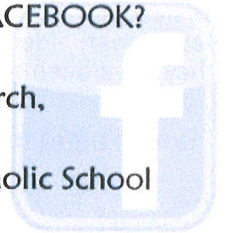

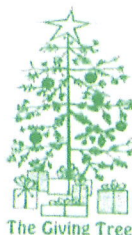
