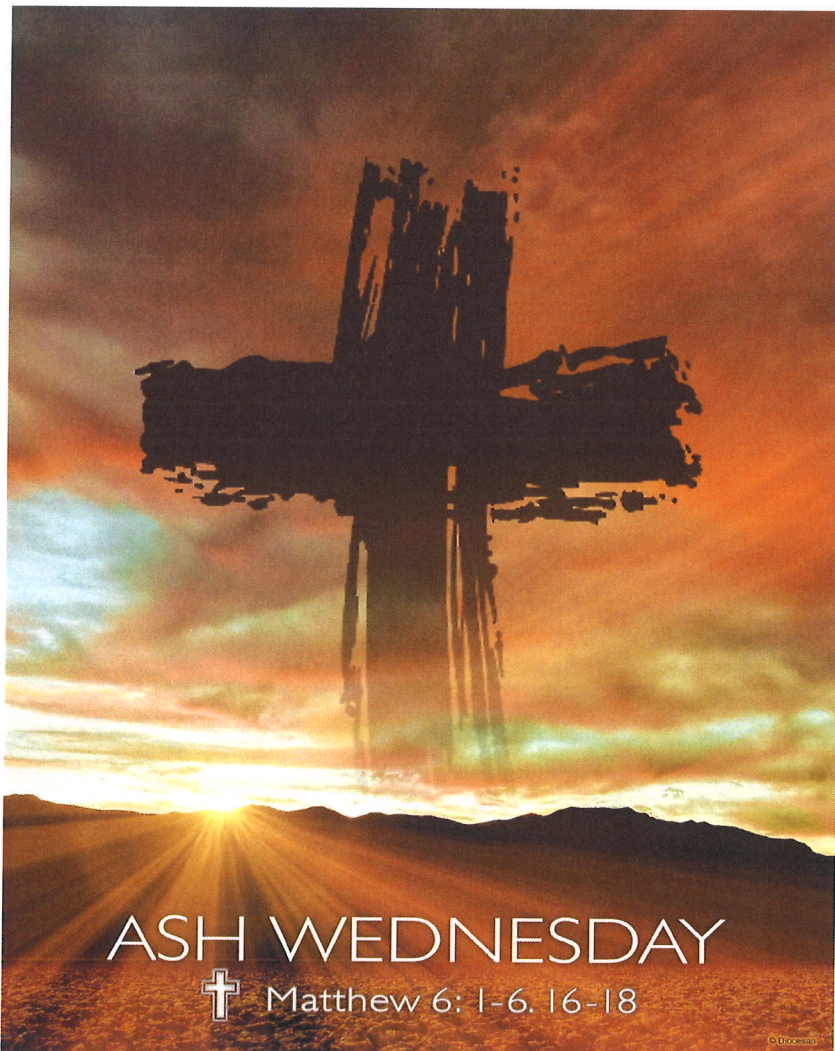

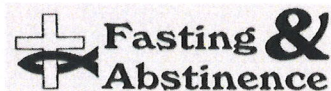

(AND WHATEVER ELSE IS ON
DEACON ERIC'S MIND)

In Search of Wisdom

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; All those who follow His commandments have a good understanding; His praise endures forever. (Psalm 111:10)

Speaking from experience, writing about wisdom is tricky business for those who seek it, but have not yet possessed it. Nonetheless, somewhere down the list after "the fear of the Lord" is an ability to recognize those who have wisdom. One of those whom I do recognize as having been wise, especially in theological circles, is the late Archbishop Fulton Sheen. It is notable today, because the Vatican has just announced that Archbishop Sheen has been approved for beatification, with the ceremony likely early this fall. Current Peoria Bishop Louis Tylka had these words of praise today:

"Archbishop Fulton Sheen was one of the greatest voices of evangelization in the Church and the world in the 20th century. I have long

admired his lifelong commitment to serve the Church as a priest, rooted in his deep devotion to the Blessed Mother and the Eucharist. As he journeyed through the different stages of his life, his ability to share the Gospel and truly relate to people drew countless souls into an encounter with Jesus—one that transformed not only his life, but more importantly, the lives of those he touched," the bishop added.

Though the word "televangelist" is almost considered a dirty word because of some who used TV to exploit Christians, Sheen preached the gospel effectively decades before some of the more recent preachers who used the media for more personal gain. Archbishop Sheen brought the Word to life during the 1950's and 60's on his TV series "Life is Worth Living". It was so successful that he won an Emmy award for it and he was on the cover of Time magazine. In receiving the Emmy, he thanked his writers – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

His preaching was so effective that he has been compared to the best preachers in all of Catholic history such as Saints Augustine, John Chrysostom and Bernard of Clairvaux. Through the relatively new

media outlet of television, his wisdom reached Catholics and non-Catholics alike. Here are just a few examples from a list of hundred possible selections:

"There are not one hundred people in the United States who hate the Catholic Church, but there are millions who hate what they wrongly perceive the Catholic Church to be."

"The refusal to take sides on great moral issues is itself a decision. It is a silent acquiescence to evil."

"If you do not live what you believe, you will end up believing what you live."

"Show me your hands. Do they have scars from giving? Show me your feet. Are they wounded in service? Show me your heart. Have you left a place for divine love?"

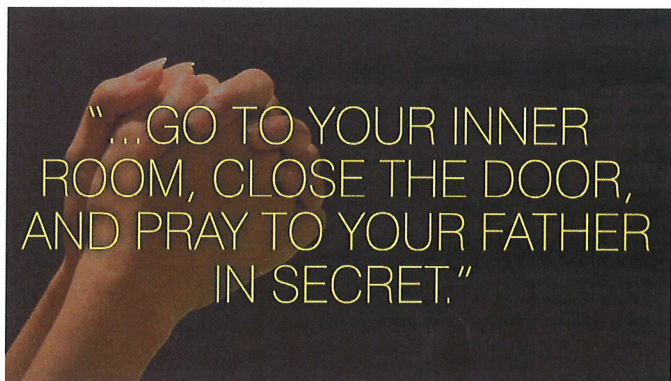

Remembering the Parish

After providing for families and loved ones, you may wish to include St. Joseph Parish in your will. All gifts are welcome, and we ask that you prayerfully consider whether a portion of your estate should be used to continue the ministries of the parish. This can be accomplished with the words: *I bequeath to St. Joseph Parish of St. Johns, Michigan, [insert amount being given or percentage of residue] to be used to support the ministry of the parish.* A bequest can be a specific dollar amount, a specific piece of property, a percentage of an estate, or all or part of the residue of an estate. It is always recommended that you consult a lawyer for drafting or amending a will.

Things Every Catholic Should Know:

What is the Church's position on cremation for burial?

Answer: Canons 1187 and 1184 of the 1983 Code of Canon Law states that no Catholic is to be deprived of the Church's funeral rites except the following, if they have died unrepentant: Notorious apostates, heretics and schismatics; Those who chose cremation for reasons opposed to the faith; Manifest public sinners whose funeral would give public scandal of the faithful. The Church recommends the practice of burying the bodies of the dead because the body was once the temple of the Holy Spirit. However, the Church does allow cremation provided it has not been chosen for reasons opposed to Christian faith such as hatred of the Church or denial of the doctrine of the resurrection of the body.

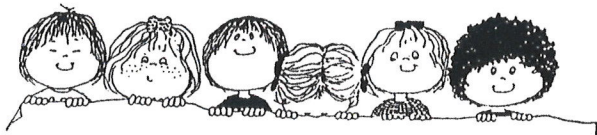
If cremation has been chosen, the Church prefers that the body be brought to the church for the funeral Mass and then taken to the crematorium. If it is physically or morally impossible for the body to be present, it is permitted to celebrate the funeral service without it.

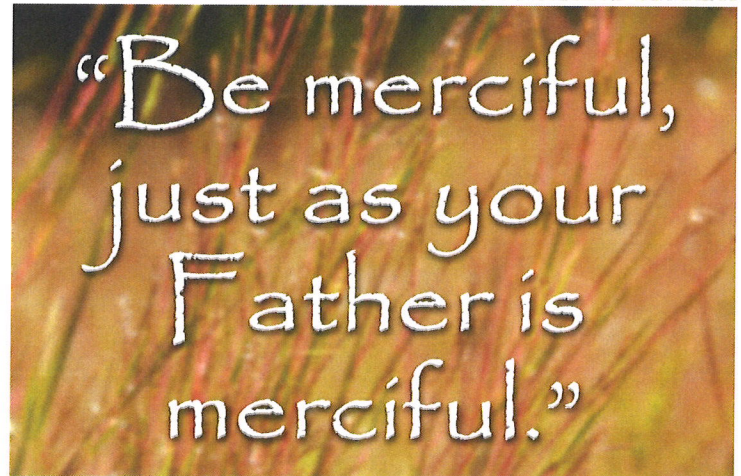
